






Agriculture is one of the leading sectors in the region's economy. There are 1114 agricultural enterprises and 121 agricultural cooperatives operating in the region.

FOOD INDUSTRY




The region's food industry is represented by 115 enterprises.




EXPORTS-IMPORTS

Foreign trade surplus is over USD 950 million.



Commodity Pattern of Export





Commodity Pattern of Import








